It brings me great joy to announce that our new organ has been installed and the Oratory's Main Chapel is back to its full operation! All Masses, Confessions, and Adoration have resumed there. At some point in the next few months, we will update the chapel lighting and make adjustments to the choir loft, but until then, we are back to using the chapel full time.

One of the questions we received during the Campaign was whether or not the organ will be played at all Masses moving forward? In short, no. As far as these updates go, we will be providing less of them now that our fundraising goal has been met and the construction is nearing its completion. We will let you know if anything newsworthy comes up!

The Oratory Lecture Series Presents

THE MONOPHYSITE CONTROVERSY: Crossroads at Chalcedon

In the early centuries of the Church, the Monophysites ("mono" = one, "physus" = nature) believed that Christ had one nature, a combination of human and divine. Against this view, the Church clarified at the Council of Chalcedon that Christ has two natures, that He is fully human and fully divine.

Monophysites thought they were holding a middle position - a "via media." St. John Henry Newman, nearing his own conversion to Roman Catholicism, found his "via media" of the Anglican Church in the same situation, not holding to a Christological heresy, but instead holding an errant way of reconciling tensions between Protestantism and Roman Catholicism.

This lecture goes deep in history, so that we can learn the lessons and remain faithful to Christ, true God and true man.
