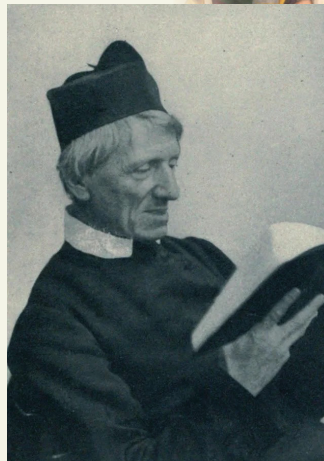
The Oratory Lecture Series Presents

THE MONOPHYSITE CONTROVERSY: CROSSROADS AT CHALCEDON

In the early centuries of the Church, the Monophysites ("mono" = one, "physus" = nature) believed that Christ had one nature, a combination of human and divine. Against this view, the Church clarified at the Council of Chalcedon that Christ has two natures, that He is fully human and fully divine.

Monophysites thought they were holding a middle position – a "via media." St. John Henry Newman, nearing his own conversion to Roman Catholicism, found his "via media" of the Anglican Church in the same situation, not holding to a Christological heresy, but instead holding an errant way of reconciling tensions between Protestantism and Roman Catholicism.

This lecture goes deep in history, so that we can learn the lessons and remain faithful to Christ, true God and true man.

Candlemas, which occurs 40 days after Christmas on February 2nd, celebrates the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. This was the day that, in keeping with Jewish law, Mary and Joseph brought the baby Jesus to the temple for the first time. Simeon, upon seeing the Child Jesus, says,

“For my eyes have seen your salvation which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a LIGHT for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel.” (Luke 2:30-32)

From these words comes the Catholic tradition of blessing of the candles.
